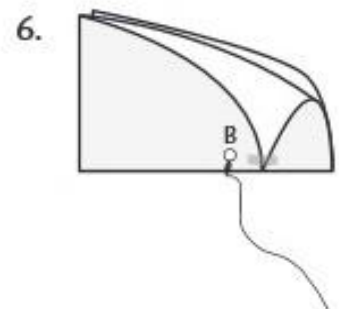
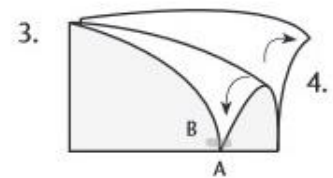
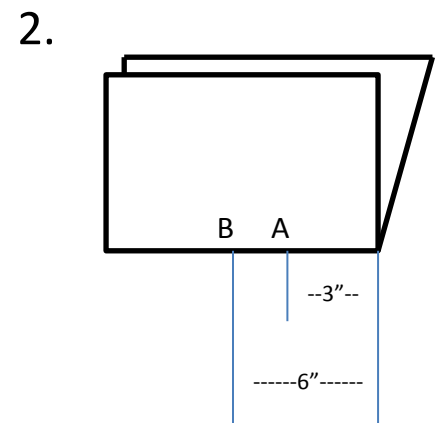
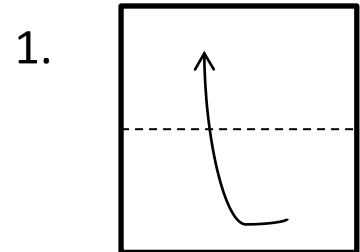


# kite making instructions



## STEPS

1. Fold the paper in half length-wise.
2. Use ruler and pencil to mark point A 3" from one end, along the folded edge. Then mark Point B 6" from the same edge.
3. Bend one corner down to Point A and tape it in place. You want it curved, so do not crease paper!
4. Turn the kite over and bend down the other corner to point A and tape it in place.
5. Tape the tail to the end of the kite (optional)
6. Punch a hole just above point B and tie on the kite.
7. Take your kite to fly!



### **How does my kite fly?**

The kite is able to fly because the air moves on the top of the wings more quickly than the air below it. This causes it to lift into the air. Air pushing against the kite causes a drag force. When the lift is greater than the drag, your kite is able to fly!
